

## Your new student e-mail account is here!

As part of a continuing effort to provide the highest quality and most innovative resources to Georgia State University students, Information Systems and Technology (IS&T) has launched PantherMail, a new student e-mail system, powered by Microsoft's Live@edu through Microsoft Exchange Labs.

## Here are some important things to remember:

- You should begin using the new system immediately, as the old system is not active.
- If you are looking for e-mail from a professor, you **MUST** use the **new** e-mail system.
- All of your incoming and official university e-mail messages are being sent to your new PantherMail account.
- You will no longer send and receive any e-mails at your old student e-mail account.
- Be sure to answer the password security questions when setting up your account.
- Old student e-mail accounts expire November 13.

## **IMPORTANT NOTE:**

If you wish to transfer e-mail from your old student e-mail account to your new account, you will have access to your old account until Wednesday, November 13 to transfer e-mail. After this date, your old student e-mail account, along with your old e-mail messages will be deleted.

If you are using PantherMail in a **NON**-Internet Explorer 7 browser, your view is considered the "Lite" version of student e-mail. This version will be enhanced over the next year. HOWEVER, you may use the student labs on campus for the "Premier" view of student e-mail. In either case, you can easily send and receive e-mail from other browsers using PantherMail.
